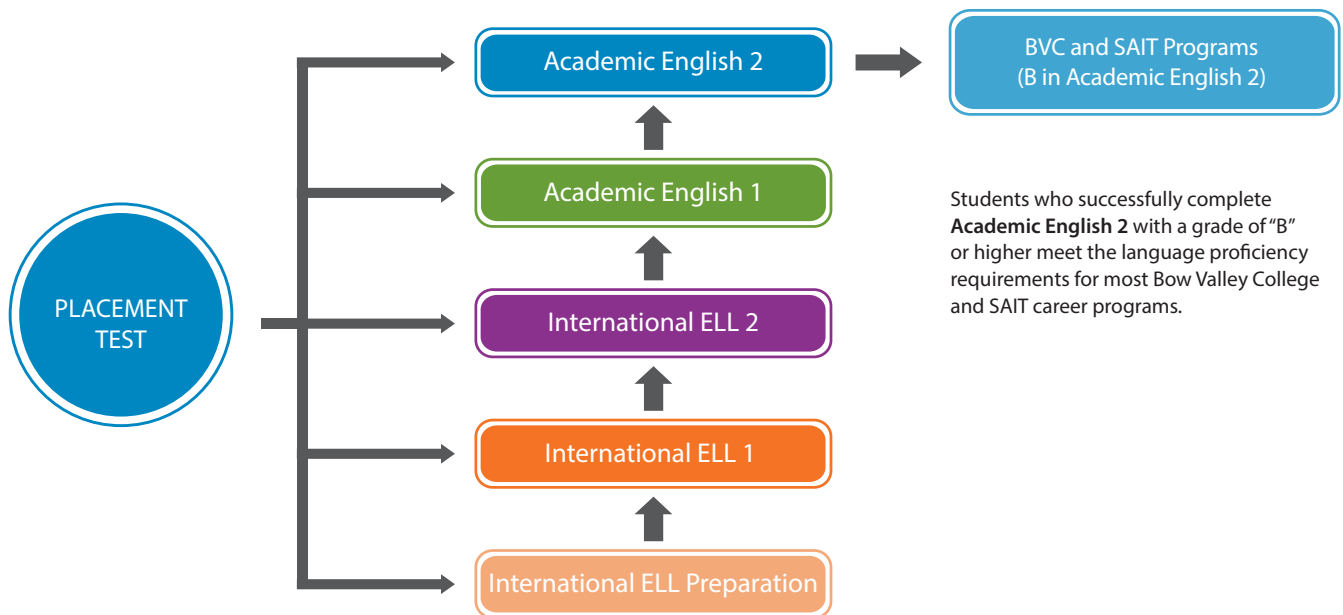


WRITING

The International ELL program offers intensive academic language courses that are outcomes-based and learner-centered. The classes focus on: **listening, speaking, reading, and writing.** Skills are developed through a range of contemporary themes, topics, and activities.

Program Structure and Student Progression

The week before classes begin, students are assessed and placed according to their language proficiency into one of the courses in the program. Applicants placed in the ELL level 1 are assumed to have at least an intermediate level of English language proficiency. For applicants with lower than intermediate proficiency, we offer the English language preparation course.



Schedule

For Fall and Winter intakes, classes for International ELL 1 and 2 are held from 9:30 a.m. to 3:50 p.m. Monday through Thursday, over 15 weeks.

For Spring intakes, classes are from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, over 13 weeks.

Academic 1 and Academic 2 are 15 week courses. Classes are held from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. Monday through Thursday.
